



We, as members of the **Latinx Social Justice Collective** at West Chester University, share in the national and transnational outrage and condemn SCOTUS's unconscionable decision to overturn Roe V. Wade.

We repudiate any laws that infringe on people's right to decide in a free and autonomous way over their own bodies, over the exercise of sexuality, reproduction, pleasure and contraception. The State has a constitutional obligation to guarantee these rights without discrimination. Criminalizing the right to voluntarily end a pregnancy is a direct attack against birthing people's human rights and particularly accentuates gender and sexual inequity.

We are thinking deeply about the disproportionate impact this will have on poor, working class, undocumented and BIPOC communities and especially on generations of our students who are already suffering from the effects of democratic deficiencies, such as economic precarity, housing and healthcare instability, and from the multipronged state-sanctioned violence against birthing people, particularly historically marginalized TQLGB+ folks.

As we process and foster spaces to grieve over this terrible news we also recommit to coalition building, to collective political education, organizing and action. We recommit to center these conversations in our classrooms and beyond as we ground our pedagogy in the reality of this moment and attentive to the lived experiences and trauma our students carry through all spaces of interaction.

We reaffirm our commitment to reproductive justice, sovereignty and the right to choose.
